

Class Corner -1/2A Measurement & Pop-Up Restaurant


Measurement

Over the past two weeks, 1/2A have been learning about measurement. They have been using informal units to estimate and measure a variety of objects. After mastering this, student moved onto comparing the lengths of crocodiles and putting them in order of smallest to largest. Some started using rulers to measure them in centimetres to check their order.


This week, 1/2A used their knowledge of length to measure the area of objects. We used geoboards to count the area in squares, and then calculated the length each side. On Thursday, they had the added challenge of creating an animal that had an area of exactly twenty-six squares.


Pop-Up Restaurant preparations

Top tips for staying connected after separation

1. Routines. Try to keep a routine in each household. Kids like rules and structure, it creates a predictable environment and will help to support the new living arrangements.

2. Give your time. You don't need to overcompensate with gifts, holidays, or expensive outings. What kids need is your time and undivided attention.

3. Stay organised. Ensure you have key dates marked in your calendar. Keep to your arrangements and inform the other parent if you are unable to do so. Children can feel easily rejected by unexplained failure to arrive at the expected time.
